**TITLE: A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 POLICE INVESTIGATION FUND BUDGET TO REFLECT THE APPROVAL OF A SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$18,500 TO BE USED FOR SPECIFIC LAW ENFORCEMENT PURPOSES AS APPROVED BY THE SEIZURE FUND COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, the Wheat Ridge Charter requires that amendments to the budget be effected by the City Council adopting a resolution.

**WHEREAS**, the Police Investigation Fund receives money from both state and federal civil forfeiture processes; and

**WHEREAS**, forfeited money, by state and federal statute, can only be used for specific law enforcement purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, historically, the Police Department has budgeted approximately \$25,000 per year from the Investigations Fund and the 2014 budgeted amount is only \$6,500; and

**WHEREAS**, the Investigations Fund currently has \$115,809 in available funds; and


**WHEREAS**, the Police Department has identified projects such as polygraph equipment upgrades, a document management system compatible with national accreditation standards and a computer tablet pilot project to enhance police operations with a projected cost of \$17,250; and

**WHEREAS**, the seizure fund committee has approved all Investigation Fund expenditures,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, as follows:**

- A. The City Council authorizes a transfer of \$18,500 from the Police Investigation Fund undesignated reserves to account number 17-202-800-809 and an amendment of the 2014 fiscal year budget accordingly.
